

# Hey friends!

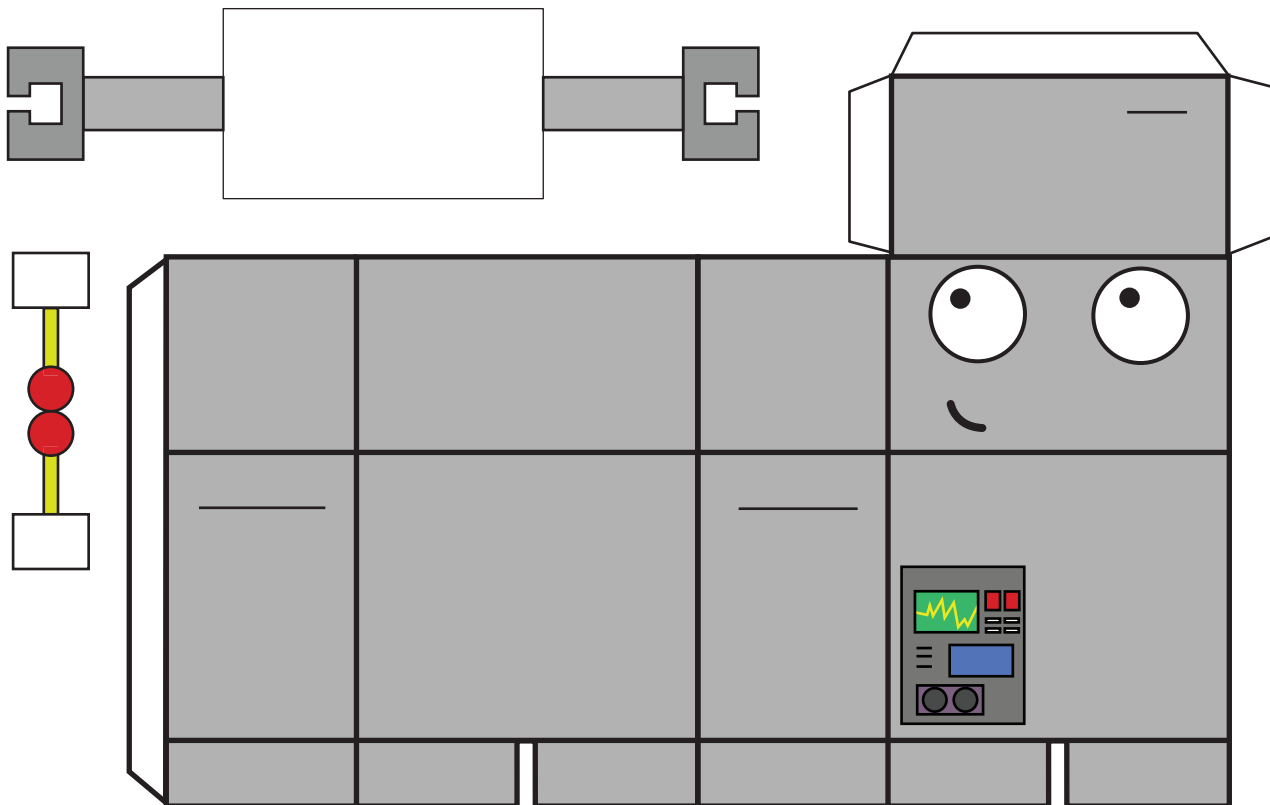
